

ORDINANCE NO. 024-52

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A
CHANGE ORDER TO A CONTRACT
WITH JASCULCA Terman
STRATEGIC COMMUNICATIONS FOR
PROFESSIONAL CONSULTING
SERVICES FOR COMMUNICATIONS
ACTIVITIES AND PUBLIC
INVOLVEMENT STRATEGIES

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority (“Authority”) requires professional consulting services for a variety of communications activities and public involvement strategies; and

WHEREAS, On April 11, 2022, the Authority entered into a contract with Jasculca Terman Strategic Communications under Requisition No. B21OP04675 for the required services for one year for the not-to-exceed amount of \$250,000.00, and the contract was extended by one year via letter; and

WHEREAS, The Authority’s Communications Department is requesting an extension of the contract for an additional twelve months, to continue focusing on the upcoming strategic plans anticipated for 2024 initiatives; and

WHEREAS, Change orders for contracts originally valued at \$1,000,000.00 or less that individually or cumulatively increase the original contract value by more than 10% or extend the original termination date by more than twelve months require approval by the Transit Board; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends approval of Change Order No. 1 to the contract with Jasculca Terman Strategic Communications for professional consulting services for a variety of communications activities and public involvement strategies to extend the contract for twelve months; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board, the President of the Authority, and the Vice President of Purchasing and Supply Chain, or their designees, are hereby authorized to execute Change Order No. 1 to the Authority’s contract with Jasculca Terman Strategic Communications for professional consulting services for a variety of communications activities and public involvement strategies to extend the contract by twelve (12) months.

SECTION 2. The Chairman, President, and Vice President of Purchasing and Supply Chain, or their designees, are further authorized to take such actions and

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execute such documents as may be necessary to implement the objectives of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
