

ORDINANCE NO. 013-30

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN
INTERGOVERNMENTAL
AGREEMENT FOR ISSUANCE OF AN
AUTHORITY/PACE SHARED FIVE-
DAY PASS FOR CUSTOMERS
AFFECTED BY THE RED LINE SOUTH
RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority (the "Authority") provides public transportation in the Chicago metropolitan area; and

WHEREAS, The Commuter Rail Division of the Regional Transportation Authority and the Northeast Illinois Regional Commuter Railroad Corporation (collectively "Metra") provides public rail transportation in the northeastern Illinois transit region; and

WHEREAS, The Suburban bus division of the Regional Transportation Authority ("Pace") provides bus public transportation in the northeastern Illinois transit region; and

WHEREAS, The Authority and Pace are authorized to enter into intergovernmental agreements under the provisions of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 5 ILCS 220/1 *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, The Authority and Pace agree to cooperate in providing linked transit services to those customers affected by the temporary closure of designated Authority rail stations during the Red Line South Reconstruction Project ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, The Authority and Pace agree that those customers affected by the Project are best served by providing a pre-packaged Authority/Pace shared five (5) day pass and a Metra ten (10) ride ticket in order to provide for a convenient form of fare payment for those linked transit services; and

WHEREAS, The Authority will be responsible for printing and encoding the Authority/Pace shared five (5) day passes; and

WHEREAS, The Authority will also be responsible for packaging, selling and distributing the pre-packaged passes and tickets via the Authority's retail network in the impacted service area; and

WHEREAS, The Authority will pay a commission payment of twenty-five cents (\$0.25) to retailers for each of the pre-packaged passes/tickets sold by the retail network; and

WHEREAS, The Authority will compensate Pace Five Dollars (\$5.00) for each Authority/Pace shared five (5) day pass sold; and

WHEREAS, The intergovernmental agreement extends until the pre-packaged Authority/Pace shared pass and Metra ticket are no longer needed; however, it can be terminated by either party on ninety (90) days written notice; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That the issuance of an Authority/Pace shared five (5) day pass to be pre-packaged by the Authority with ten (10) ride Metra tickets for sale to customers affected by the Red Line South Reconstruction Project temporary rail station closures is approved.

SECTION 2. That the Authority will pay a commission of twenty-five cents (\$0.25) to retailers for each of the pre-packaged passes/tickets sold by the retail network to customers in the impacted service area.

SECTION 3. That the Chairman, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an intergovernmental agreement ("IGA") with Pace Suburban Bus through which the Authority and Pace agree to issue an Authority/Pace shared five (5) day pass and the Authority agrees to compensate Pace for each Authority/Pace shared five (5) day pass sold at the rate of Five Dollars (\$5.00) per pass.

SECTION 4. The IGA shall have a term that extends until the pre-packaged Authority/Pace shared pass is no longer needed, can be terminated by either party on ninety (90) days' notice, and contains such other terms and conditions as are substantially in conformance with Exhibit A, attached hereto.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
