We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

EXTENDED PARTIAL-ALLEY CLOSURE

Weekdays & Saturdays

Dates: Tuesday, September 3 to Saturday, September 14, 2024

Location: W. Foster Avenue to W. Berwyn Avenue
- The alley west of 5200 – 5268 N. Winthrop Avenue
- The alley east of 5201 – 5259 N. Broadway

Work Hours: 7am to 7pm (continuous 24/7 partial-alley closure)

Work Activity: Station Wall Construction

Local Impact:

- The entrance to both alleys east and west of the CTA Tracks at W. Berwyn Avenue will be closed until the work activity is complete.
- **Due to ongoing work restricting access to the alley behind 5200 – 5268 N. Winthrop Avenue via W. Foster Avenue, there will be a temporary east/west path through CTA right-of-way, mid-block in the alley to maintain access to garages/parking spaces for 5200 – 5240 N. Winthrop Avenue.**
- Access to the alley on the west side of the CTA Tracks will be maintained from W. Foster Avenue at all times.
- **Access to the garages/parking spaces behind 5246 – 5248 N. Winthrop Avenue will be closed until the work activity is complete.**
- Contractor will provide alternative parking for impacted residents. For further information about alternative parking, please contact Walsh-Fluor at cpoole@walshgroup.com.
- The contractor will maintain garbage and recycling pickup.
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
