Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. EXTENDED STREET CLOSURE

Weekend-Overnight

Dates: Friday April 5 to Monday, April 8, 2024

Location: W. Bryn Mawr Avenue at the CTA Tracks

Work Hours: 9pm-Friday to 5am-Monday (Continuous around the clock work)

(Prep work will begin at least ½ hour prior to start of shift)

Work Activity: Station Escalator Steel Erection

Local Impact:

- W. Bryn Mawr Avenue at the CTA Tracks will be closed to vehicular and bicycle traffic.
- Local access will be maintained on W. Bryn Mawr Avenue east and west of the CTA Tracks outside of the work zone.
- Sidewalk closures within the work zone will alternate between the north and south sides of W. Bryn Mawr Avenue.
- One sidewalk will remain open with flagger assistance when necessary. (The contractor will close the sidewalk if it is deemed unsafe).
- Access to businesses on W. Bryn Mawr Avenue will be maintained.
- Access to the Bryn Mawr station entrance on W. Bryn Mawr Avenue will be maintained at all times.
- There will be noise while work is being performed, including nighttime noise:
 - General construction noise
 - Noise from crane lifting and setting equipment/material
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction vehicles and equipment
