We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

Dates: Saturday, September 14 to Saturday, September 21, 2024

Location: W. Ainslie Street at the CTA Tracks

Work Hours: 7am-7pm;

Work Activity: Track Structure Segment Installation

Local Impact:

- W. Ainslie Street at the CTA Tracks will be closed to vehicular and bicyclist traffic during stated work hours.
- Local access will be maintained west of the CTA Tracks outside of the work zone.
- Access to South-East Asia Center School's drop-off and pick-up location (via the alley west of the tracks) will be maintained at all times.
- W. Ainslie Street between the CTA Tracks and N. Winthrop Avenue will be two-way only for the duration of this closure.
- Access for garages/parking spaces and the parking garage for 4848 N. Winthrop Avenue will be maintained via two-way traffic on W. Ainslie Street.
- Sidewalk closures within the work zone will alternate between the north and south sides of W. Winona Street.
- One sidewalk will remain open with flagger assistance when necessary.
- There will be noise while work is being performed, including:
 - o General construction noise
 - Noise from lifting and setting track segments
 - o Beeping from backup alarms on construction vehicles and equipment
 - There will be light in the work area
