We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

Dates: Thursday, April 11 to Saturday, April 20, 2024

Location: 3353 – 3403 N. Clark Street
W. Roscoe Street from N. Clark Street east to 932 W. Roscoe Street

Work Hours: 7am-7pm; continuous 24/7 sidewalk impacts

Work Activity: Sidewalk Reconstruction

Local Impact: N. Clark Street

- The sidewalk on the east side of N. Clark Street, north and south of W. Roscoe Street, will be closed until the work activity is completed.
- The sidewalk on the west side of N. Clark Street will remain open at all times.
- Access to the front doors of 3355 & 3365 N. Clark Street will be maintained via a temporary walkway.
- Residents of 3355 & 3365 N. Clark Street are encouraged to use secondary entrances in the rear of buildings (*emergency egress maintained via primary entrances*).
- Access to businesses will be maintained.

W. Roscoe Street

- Sidewalk closures will alternate between the north and south sides of W. Roscoe Street.
- Temporary pedestrian paths will be provided for east-west travel on W. Roscoe Street around the work zone.
- Access to the front of 934 W. Roscoe Street will be maintained via a temporary walkway.
- Residents of 934 W. Roscoe Street are encouraged to use the secondary entrance in the rear of the building (*emergency egress maintained via primary entrances*).
- The alley entrance on the north side of W. Roscoe Street will be closed until the work activity is complete.
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - **Loud noise from sidewalk demolition**
 - Beeping from backup alarms construction equipment and vehicles
