Connelly, your Chief Planning Officer. Staff are 1 recommending approval of an agreement between CTA 2 and the University of Chicago for service on three 3 4 bus routes for five -- for a period of five years. This includes increases to the hourly rate as 5 negotiated between the university and the city 6 staff based on numbers from our finance department. 7 The CTA revenue over the five year life of this 8 9 contract will be 16 million dollars. CTA and the university have had a contract since 2000 on this 10 11 cooperative agreement to provide service in -- in the greater Hyde Park, Kenwood, Woodlawn area. 12 If you would go to the next slide. This particular 13 14 agreement covers three bus routes. The 171 and the 15 172 which provide local service for students and 16 residents in the Hyde Park, Kenwood, Woodlawn and 17 university area on the south side. They operate year-round with a slightly wider headway in the 18 19 summertime. The number 192 route which is also 20 funded under this agreement that operates between 21 the university hospitals complex and downtown Metra 22 and CTA rail stations. This particular route 23 serves both residents and commuters who are coming 24 It is -- it is operated year -in on Metra.

1	year-round on weekdays during both the a.m. and	
2	p.m. rush periods to serve the hospital's employees	
3	as well as other residents who are commuting to and	
4	from the Hyde Park area. The staff recommends	
5	adoption of this and I'll be glad to try to answer	
6	any questions for the board members.
